PERSONAL DATA

The personal data that may be collected on the Website are as follows:

- **Cookies:** Cookies are used as part of the use of the Website to collect certain information (in particular your IP address, information related to the computer used for browsing, the connection mode, the type and version of the internet browser, the operating system, and other technical identifiers or even the URL of connections, including the date and time, as well as the accessed content). You can disable Cookies from your browser settings.
- **Contact Form:** When filling out the contact form, your first name, last name, email address, and your message are collected.
- The main uses of your personal data are as follows: managing the relationship with you; providing content and services personalised according to your browsing history, preferences, and interests.
- When certain information is mandatory to access specific functionalities of the Website, this mandatory nature is indicated at the time of data entry. If you refuse to provide mandatory information, you may not have access to certain services, functionalities, or sections of the Website.

- During this period, the Website implements organisational, software, legal, technical, and physical means to ensure the confidentiality and security of your personal data to prevent their damage, erasure, or access by unauthorised third parties.

ACCESS TO PERSONAL DATA

Access to your personal data is strictly limited to the personnel and sales agents of the Agency authorised by virtue of their functions and bound by an obligation of confidentiality.

- Request the limitation of the processing of your data.
- Oppose, for legitimate reasons, the processing of your data.
- Oppose or withdraw your consent to the use of your data by our services for sending promotions and solicitations via email, SMS, phone calls, and postal mail. This right remains valid whether the information concerning you was transmitted directly by you or by third-party partners to whom you communicated them (in this case, you must click on the unsubscribe links provided in our SMS or emails or contact us under the conditions below).
